

REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR UNITY BIKE RIDE MAY 22, 2010

Registration

Pre-register by mail by May 7, 2010 along with your registration fee. We will confirm your registration by mail if you include a SASE or by e-mail if you include that on the registration form. Registration will include a \$5 coupon toward the Saturday meal. Family Registrations will include a \$10 coupon.

Route Options

“Encouragement” Ride is a 10-mile loop designed for the younger student, families or beginning riders.

(One rest stop)

“Unity” Ride is an easy 15-mile ride. You can take your time or set a fast pace. Either way, 25% of the profits from this ride will to the Oostburg Community Education Foundation. (One rest stop)

“Spirit” Ride is a 35-mile ride that will take you through scenic countryside (Two rest stops)

Foundation Ride will celebrate the 60 years of Christian education in Oostburg. We will honor that with a 60-mile loop out through the scenic hills of the Kettle Moraine and back. (Three rest stops)

“Endurance” Ride is a 100-mile ride that has it all! Prepare for a beautiful ride through the Kettle Moraine and picturesque countryside. (Four rest stops)

General Ride Information

On Friday, May 21, you will have the opportunity to check in for the ride from 4:00-6:00 p.m. Riders may pick up their packets.

Lodging is available in a nearby hotel. Camping will be available on the school grounds at no charge. If we have no pre-registrations for this, the grounds will still be available, but no restroom or shower facilities will be. See registration form.

Safety

A primary concern will be for the safety of our riders. We ask that all riders watch out for others as well as themselves. Some routes are on public roads and must be shared with motor vehicles.

Please slow down on hills. Most bicycling injuries involve head injuries. Therefore, we **require helmets, and headphones are prohibited** so that riders can hear other vehicles as well as other riders.

Routes

All routes are on paved roads or bike trails selected for safety and scenic vistas. Terrain will be rolling with some challenging hills. Routes will be marked.

We will have personnel to provide SAG service on all routes to aid in emergency situations and mechanical problems. Riders and their equipment are expected to be in condition to finish the ride on their own.

Directions to the School

Oostburg Christian is located in the village of Oostburg, one block south of Center Avenue. Coming in from the west or the east, take Center Avenue to 7th Street, turn south, and the school parking lot is on your left.

Rest Stops and Food

Rest stops will be located on your route maps and clearly marked. There will be a plentiful supply of nutritious, high energy food and drinks. Check your map for location of each rest stop. Your rider number will be your ticket for the rest stops.

A brat and hamburger fry will be served in the school Student Center from 11:00 until 3:00 p.m. on the day of the ride, ala carte, payable at the door.
